Whilst all 2020 competitive League matches were cancelled due to UK Gov coronavirus restrictions, we were able to organise social bowls during the latter part of the summer, so all was not lost.

Whilst we stop bowling through the winter months, the organisational wheels keep turning in the background and we approached the Parish Council seeking approval to move some of the perimeter hedging to create a bit more space within the club grounds.

We received approval from the Parish Council in Autumn 2020, and we would like to record our thanks for their support.

The excavation and transplanting of the hedgerow was done in early January and we restarted in March once the weather improved (with a little less rain and snow).

So, what next?

Work is scheduled to be completed during Spring / Summer 2021 and should not interfere with access for bowling through the summer.

Will we be bowling again in 2021?

In truth, nobody knows how the COVID 19 restrictions will unfold, however, we remain in regular contact with Bowls England, Suffolk County Bowls Association and our local affiliated leagues.

We anticipate that the start of the league season will be delayed, although social bowls will be permitted so a schedule of informal roll-ups will be prepared to commence early in May 2021.
